

Laporan Penyelidikan: Bibliografi Eropah Tentang Serba-Serbinya Tamadun Melayu Sebelum Dari Tahun 1800 Masihi

PENGENALAN

Pada tahun 2005, satu senarai buku-buku Eropah berkenaan alam Melayu telah diterbitkan dalam Jurnal Kesturi (lihat Alinor: 2005). Senarai tersebut merupakan pungutan daripada beberapa sumber. Senarai tersebut kemudiannya ditambah baik dengan tersenarainya versi-versi bahasa Inggeris untuk sumber selain Inggeris seperti Portugis, Belanda dan Sepanyol (jika ada), memasukkan pungutan-pungutan baru yang diperolehi dari internet, serta membetulkan pentarikhan berdasarkan bandingan data secara kolektif.

Data-data yang ditampilkan ini adalah sebagai rujukan kepada para sarjana yang ingin mendapatkan gambaran masyarakat di alam Melayu pada kurun ke-16 hingga ke-18 baik dari segi ekonominya, sistem perundangannya termasuklah sains dan teknologinya. Kebanyakan daripada buku-buku dalam senarai di bawah ini dapat diakses dan dimuat turun dari laman-laman sesawang dan ditandakan dengan simbol  di hujung tajuk sesebuah buku tersebut.

SENARAI BUKU-BUKU EROPAH BERKENAAN ALAM MELAYU

Senarai buku-buku Eropah berkenaan alam Melayu ini disusun mengikut sumber bahasanya. Sumber bahasa ini dipecahkan kepada empat macam iaitu 1) sumber Portugis, 2) sumber Belanda, 3) sumber Sepanyol, dan 4) sumber-sumber Eropah lain (seperti Inggeris, Jerman dan Itali). Senarai ini kemudiannya ditulis mengikut format berikut iaitu 1) tahun terbitan, 2) nama penulis, 3) tajuk buku (bertulisan *italik*), 4) tempat diterbitkan, dan 5) nama penerbit. Kemudian ditambah pula pada senarai tersebut judul buku yang diulang cetak atau diterjemah ke bahasa Inggeris atau diterbitkan oleh penerbit yang lain. Ini bagi tujuan memudahkan pencarian buku-buku tersebut di laman sesawang. Berikut merupakan senarai buku-buku Eropah berkenaan alam Melayu setakat yang ditemui sehingga akhir tahun 2013:
